#### **ABOUT BFIA:**

Borneo Football International Academy kicked off in 2015 with just 14 children - word quickly spread. Today, eight years later, the Academy has 340 players, including three all-girls teams, and reaches more than 2000 students in local schools through football training, health, and education programs. Our mission is to improve the quality of life of underprivileged children in Kalimantan through sports. Using football as a tool for social change assists their physical and mental development, health, and education.

The foundation has three complementary programs – Football Practice, Education, and Health - promote gender equality, empower women, motivate young people to pursue formal education, and have better job opportunities. In addition, it provides a safe environment for children to play sports, and it promotes tolerance in diversity for a peace-building community.
